

Instructions for this Course

- 1. Videos Watch every video as many times as needed, until you grasp the concept and understand the material.
- 2. Reading The reading material is used to further your understanding of the concepts and the links are located at the bottom of the page, under the videos. The quizzes will be generated from the materials in the videos and readings.
- 3. Quizzes Quizzes are mandatory and are worth 10% of your grade. You can take them as many times as you'd like, though, and we keep the highest grade.
- 4. Unit Assignment and Lab Unit assignments and unit labs are required, they are worth 35% of your grade. Complete the assignment and lab before you take the unit test as some questions on the test relate to the lab or assignment. Please allow 2-3 days for an assignment to be graded.
- 5. Unit Tests Once you have viewed all the learning material, and completed all of the quizzes in a unit, the unit test will become visible. You get 1 attempt at each unit test and there is a 3-hour time limit. Unit tests are worth 35% of your final grade. Use the quizzes in the unit as practice before you attempt the unit test.
- 6. The Practice Final Exam This exam is NOT mandatory and NOT graded, but is highly recommended, and will prepare you for the final exam. You can take it as many times as you'd like.
- 7. The Final Exam Once you have completed all of the unit tests and all your assignments and labs have been graded, the final exam will become visible. You get one attempt at the final exam, it is worth 20% of your grade. There is a time limit of 3 hours.
- 8. Course Completion You will receive a letter grade for the course.
- 9. Course Completion Record Once you have satisfied all the course completion requirements. Use the 'request a course complete record' link to have Silicon Valley High School send a record of course completion to your high school.

We recommend that you complete all the unit quizzes, the unit assignment and unit test <u>before</u> moving on to the next unit.
