## Unit 1: Las Fiestas y Celebraciones (Parties and Celebrations)

In this unit we will review and practice key concepts from Spanish 1, including present tense verbs, adjective noun agreement, the use of the verbs ser and estar (to be) and direct and indirect object pronouns. We will also review preterite regular verbs and ser and ir (to be, to go) in the past tense.

We will learn how to use the imperfect tense and have an introduction on the differences between the two past tenses, imperfect and preterite.
